2012 ASRT Student Leadership Development Program attendees were selected from 170 submissions from 39 ASRT affiliate states. They received airfare, housing, stipend for meals and other travel expenses, an educational program designed just for students (non CE), and the opportunity to network with Radiologic Technologists from across the nation, as a professional ASRT mentor was assigned to them for the entire Educational Symposium and Annual Governance and House of Delegates Meeting.

The fifty students have been selected for the 2013 June 13-16<sup>th</sup> in Albuquerque, NM. I am excited to announce that Candice Dillard, senior student in Trinity Hospital School of Radiologic Technology in Minot, ND has been accepted.

The selected 50 students must have submitted their applications to ASRT by December 15, 2012. To be eligible, they needed to be student members of ASRT as well as an affiliate member, attending an accredited program and submit an essay of 500-700 words, answering the question "How would you grow professionally from your participation in the SLDP".
